

BC Rural Site Visits Program - Meeting Guide (Group Community Meeting)

These questions are used as a guide to facilitate our meetings with municipal leadership and community members. We prefer to keep the meeting un-structured and open, so if there are topics that are not covered in our questions we are still very interested to discuss them with you.

1. Tell us about your community.
 - a. What are its unique features? (Special populations, relationships, notable services, catchment area, etc.)
 - b. What supports do you have?
 - c. Connection with Divisions? To the health authority? Relationships with other nearby communities? Relationship with healthcare providers?
2. Tell us about the health services available to the community.
 - a. What services are currently provided? Regularly or occasionally? Allied health services?
 - b. What services would you like to provide?
 - c. What services are currently at risk?
 - d. Tell us about emergency transport services
3. Tell us about your isolation.
4. Tell us about geographical context.
5. What role does the community play in recruitment and retention of healthcare providers?
