

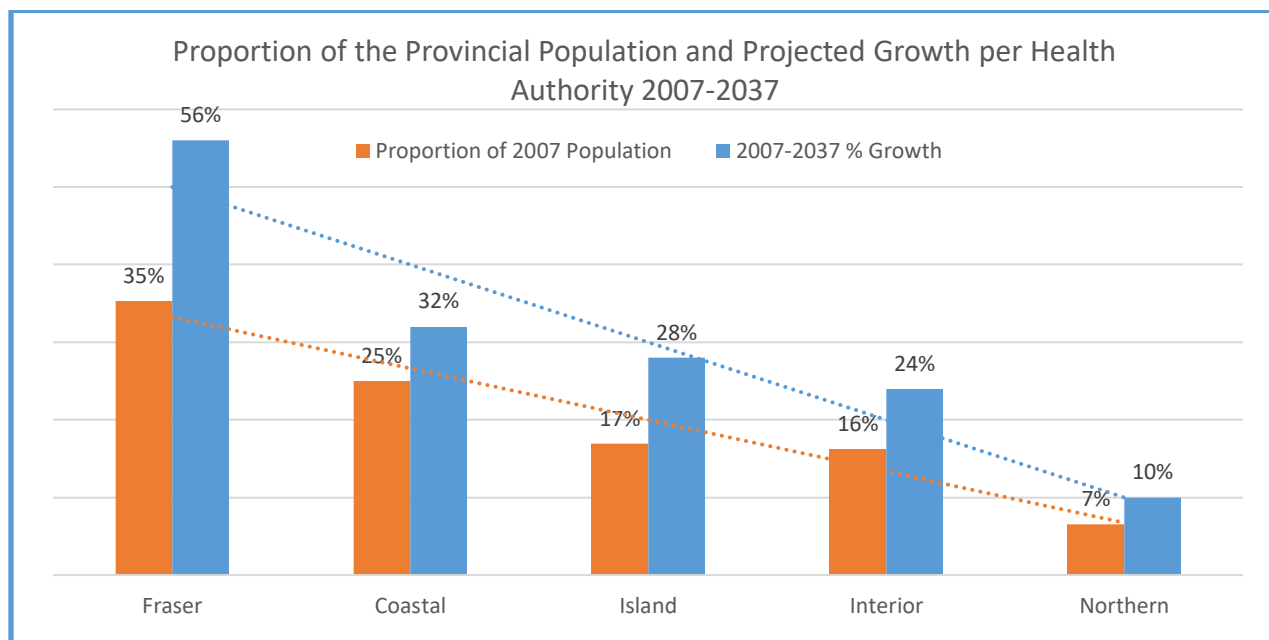

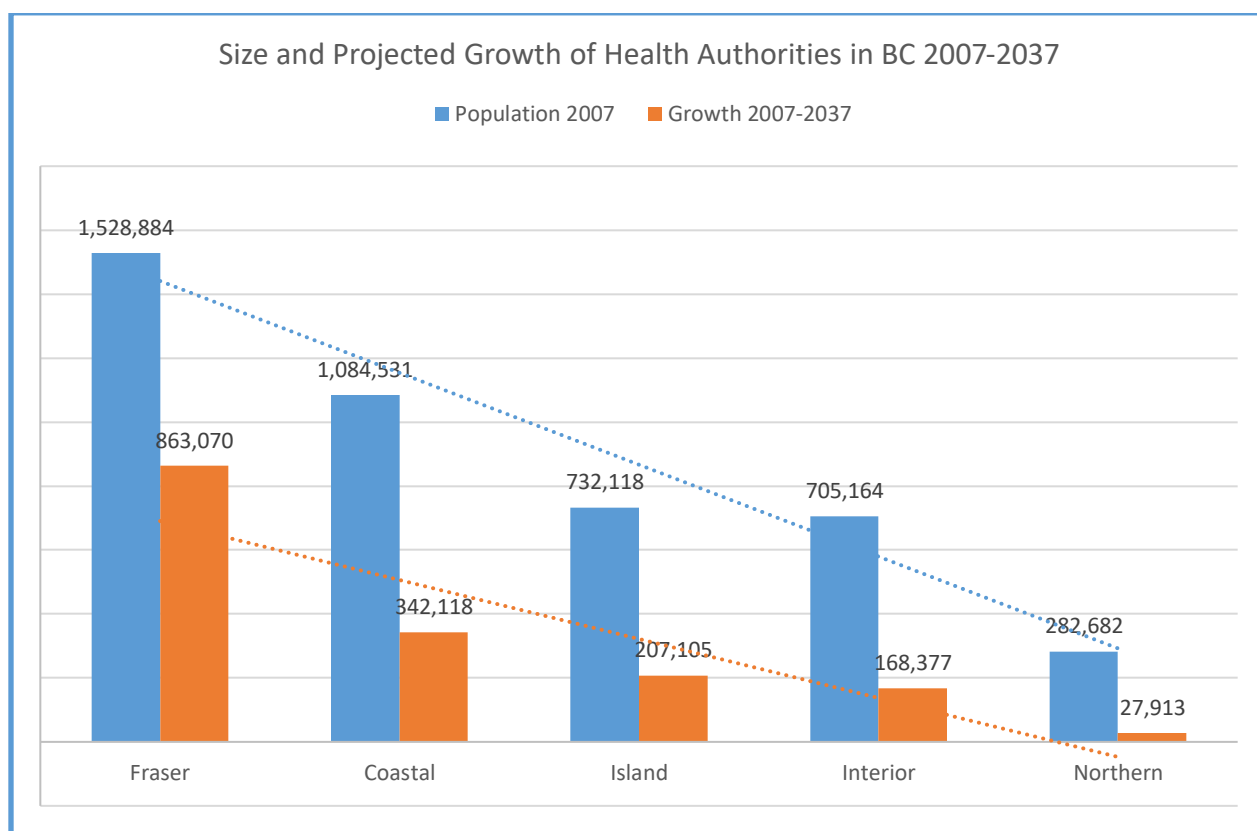
The more populous the HA, the higher it's projected growth rate. This demonstrated the continued urbanization of British Columbia during the first half of the 21st century.

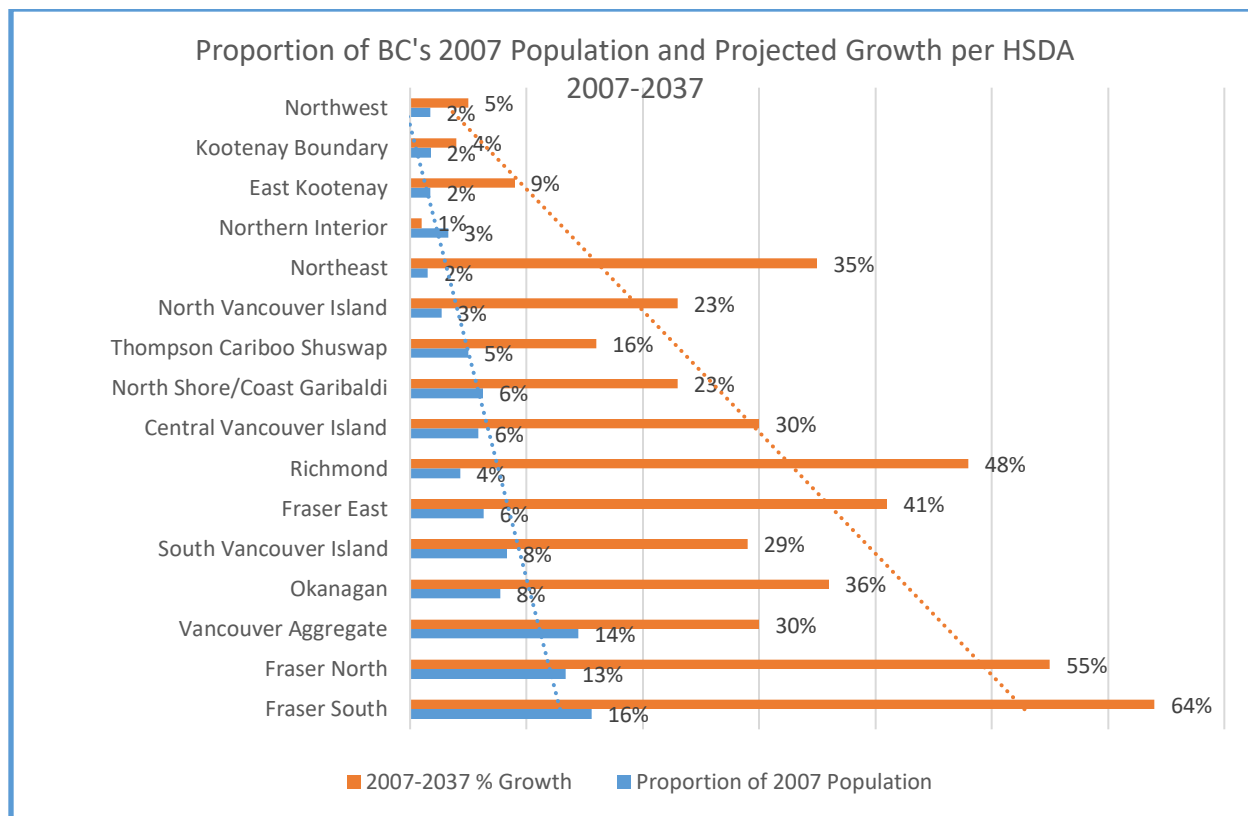

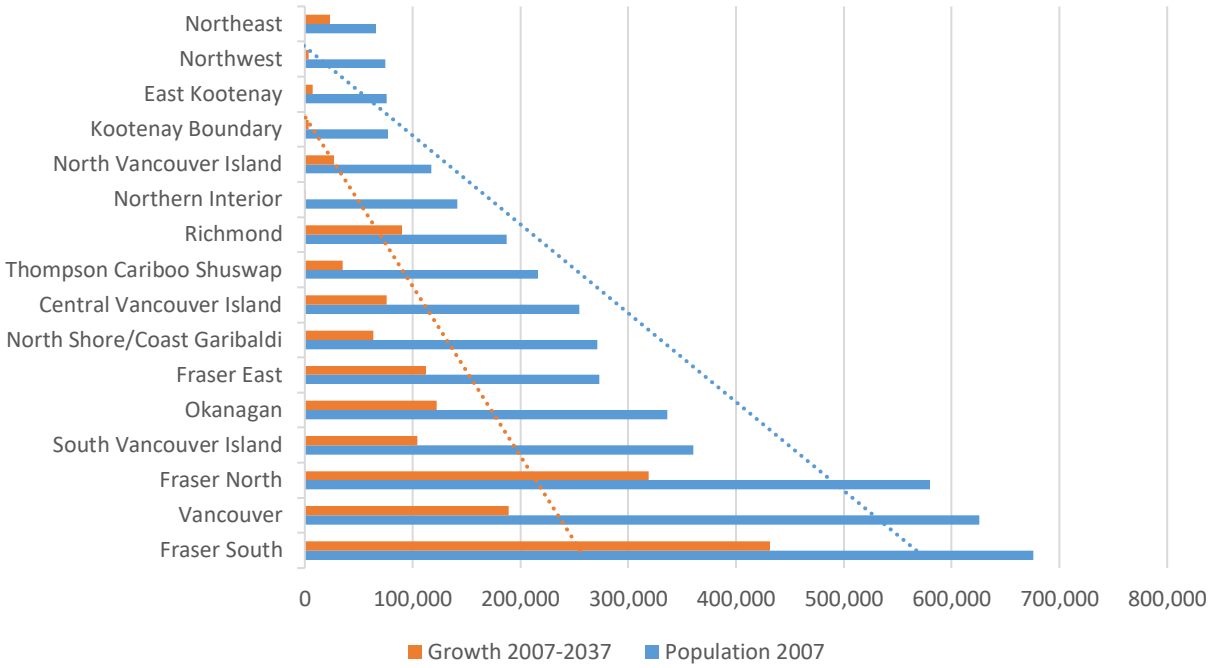


Health Service Delivery Area - projected growth (in numbers) for the 2007-2037 period.
