In the Quality Team Coaching for Rural BC (QTC4RBC) program, rural community health care teams work with an International Coaching Federation certified coach to optimize their team culture of safety, learning, and quality.

Why do Quality Team Coaching?

Evidence shows that effective teams create a culture that both improves patient safety and enhances satisfaction and joy for healthcare providers.

What the Program Provides:

- ❖ One day in-person workshop in your community **OR** 6 online 2 hour modules with an ICF-certified coach
- ❖ 4 virtual team coaching sessions over 6 months
- ❖ Financial support up to \$40,000 for further team educational or QI opportunities
- ❖ Opportunity to work on a quality project with mentorship
- ❖ 21.75 CCFP Mainpro+ credits, 7.25 MOC Section 3 Simulation hours



Program Eligibility:

- ❖ Any rural health care team, with priority given to:
 - [RSA A or B communities](#)
 - Remote and/or vulnerable populations
 - Interprofessional teams
 - Leadership participation in the program
