

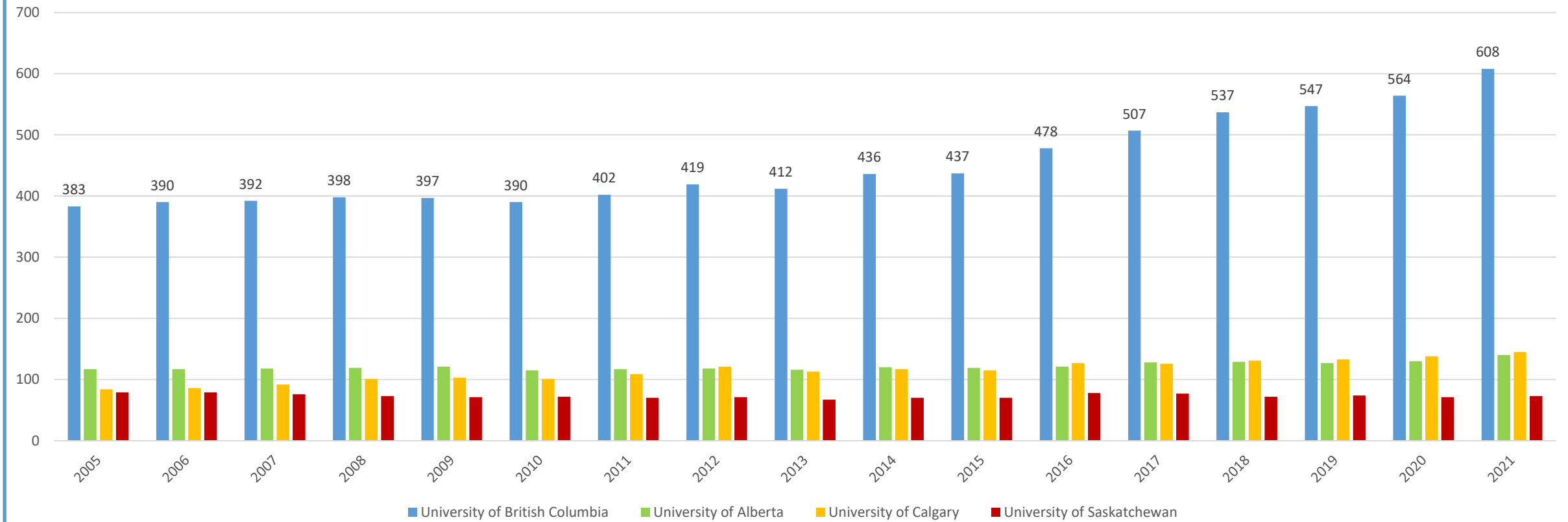

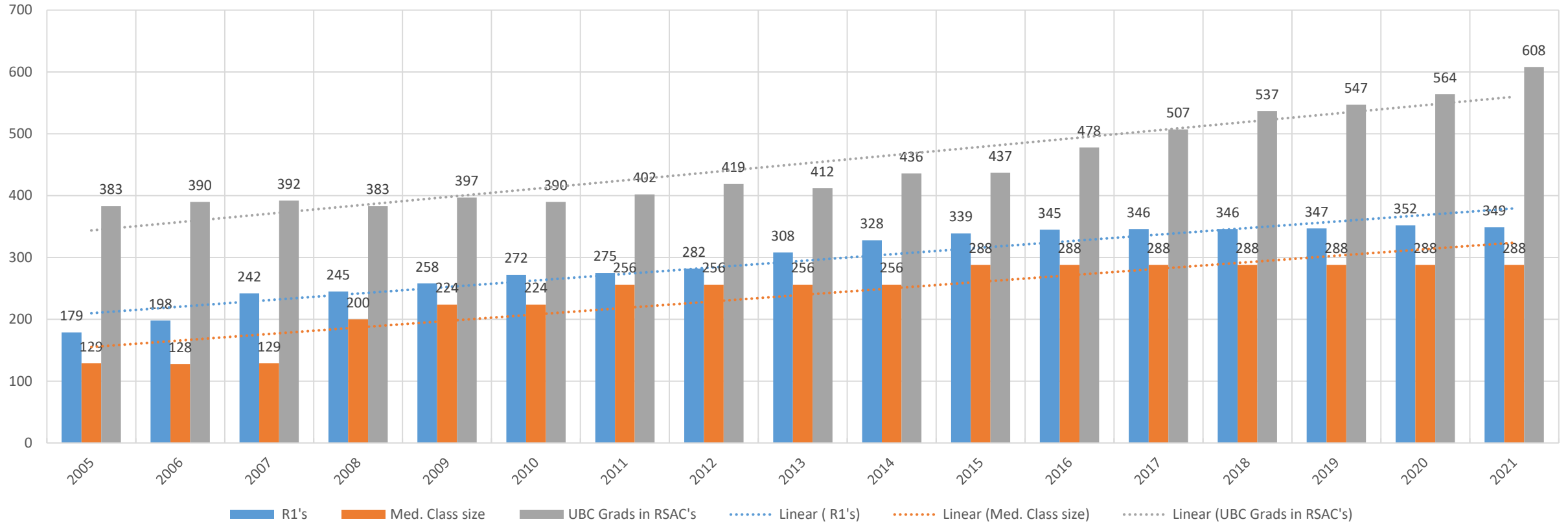

UBC MD's Awarded, R1 Sizes and UBC RSAC Physicians



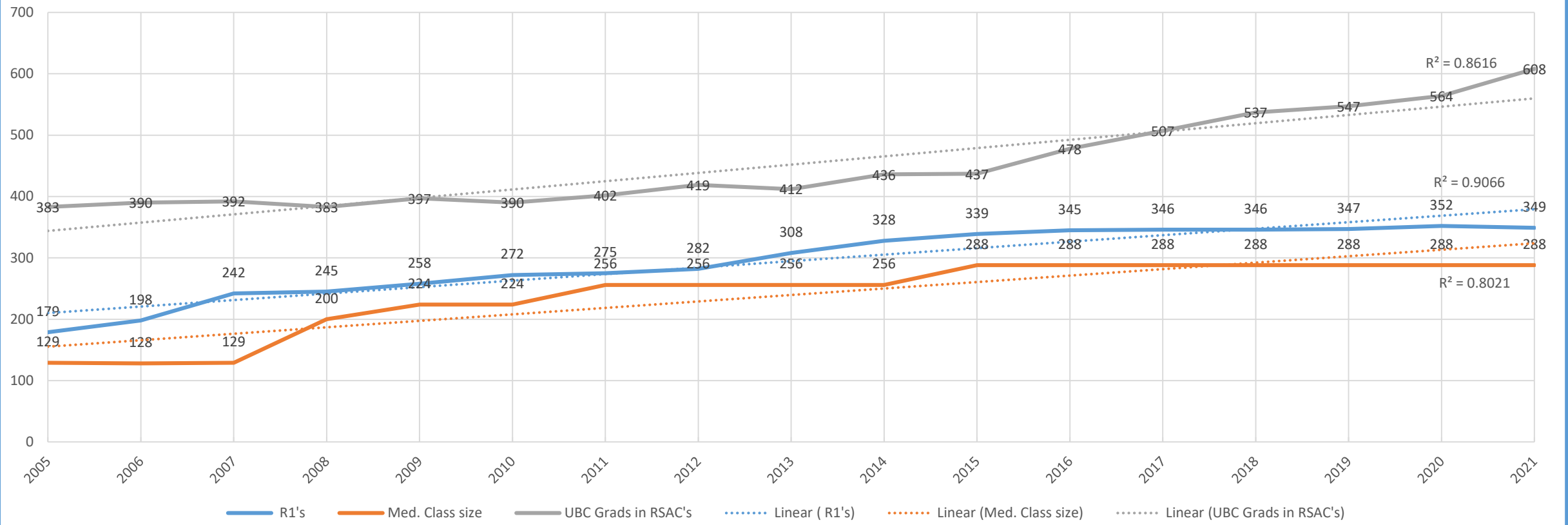

UBC MD Class Sizes, R1 Sizes and UBC RSAC Physicians Numbers



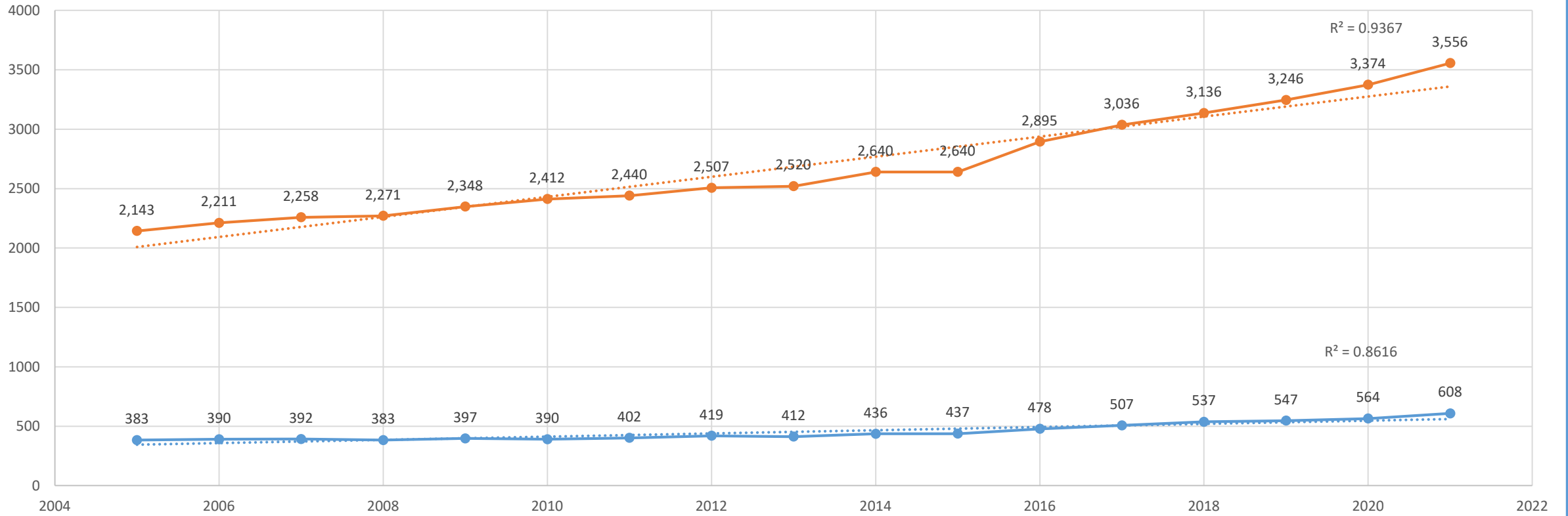

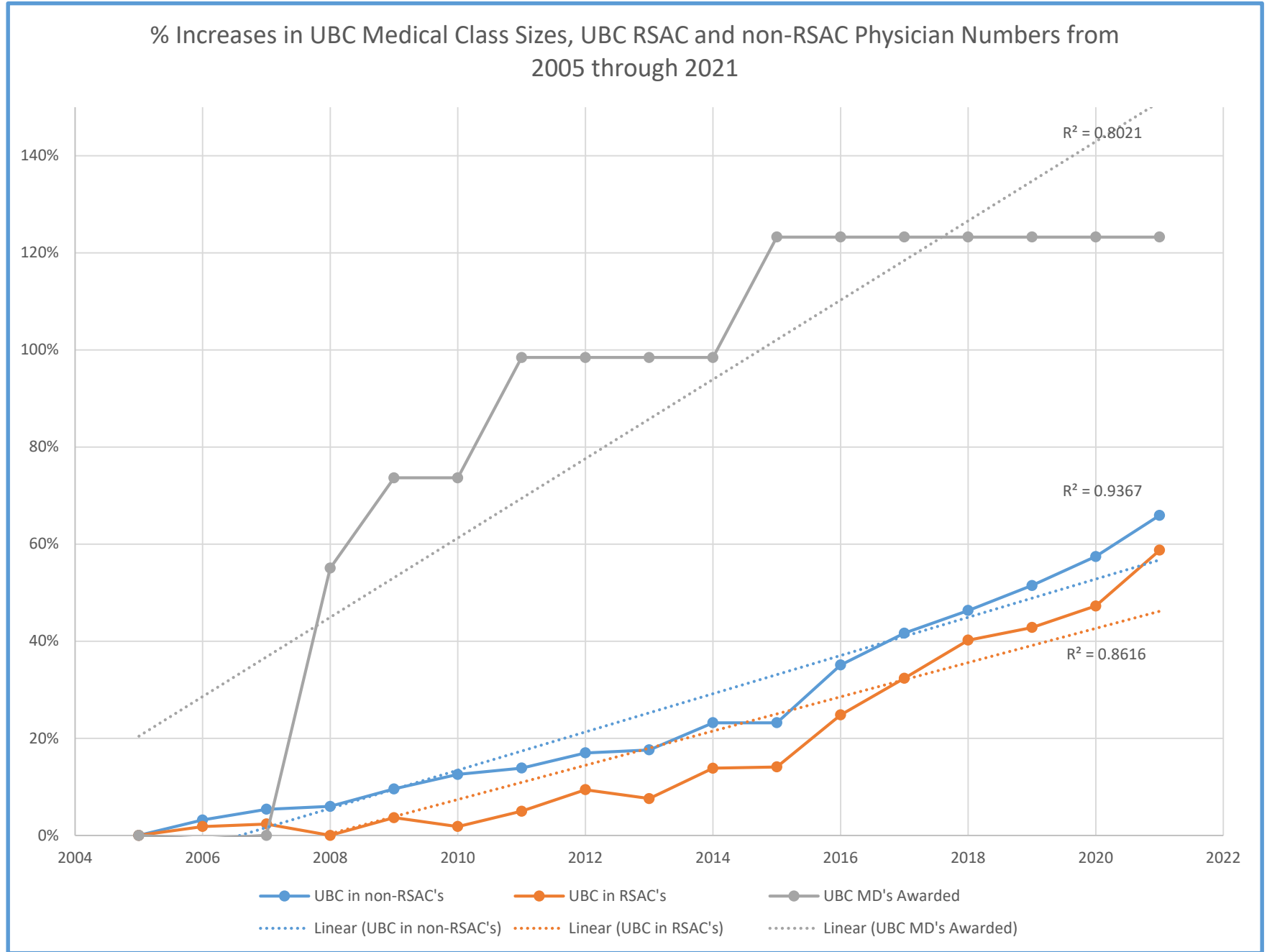

Over the past 16 years:

The number of UBC awarded MD's choosing to work in RSAC's has increased 59%.

The number of UBC awarded MD's choosing to work in non-RSAC's has increased 65%.

The proportion of UBC awarded MD's choosing to work in RSAC's and non-RSAC's is stable and therefore predictable.

UBC School of Medicine Class sizes have increased 123%.
