 - Scheduling an in-person meeting in community, with support from RCCbc
- Validating discussion summaries using auto-transcription software

Training & Support:

In-person facilitator training will be held in Vancouver, with multiple dates available ahead of the Gathering.

Travel and expenses will be covered by RCCbc according to the reimbursement schedule, and an honorarium will be provided for participating in training and for time spent facilitating dialogue.
